

Hope Lego Suffragette – Loan Request

Hope, our Lego Suffragette, is now available to loan to organisations across the UK to help tell the story of women’s suffrage 100 years after the first women gained the right to vote.

Hope was built in 2018 for the UK Parliament’s Education and Engagement team, to help us tell the story of women’s suffrage 100 years after the first women gained the right to vote. We asked the public to #NameOurSister, and they chose Hope!

In ten years we will be celebrating the 1928 Representation of the People (Equal Franchise) Act, which gave equal voting rights to all women and men. Building Hope and seeing her tour the UK in the lead up to 2028 is a great way to celebrate this centenary!

Details about Hope

Hope was Built by The Lego Group. It took three people 171 hours to build her. She’s made from 32,327 bricks and is 170cm tall. Hope is designed for indoor use, can be touched and photographed, but not climbed on. You will need to make sure you have a suitable space for her. We would be happy to give advice on this.

Dimensions

- Height: 170 cm
- Width: 84 cm
- Depth: 71 cm

Total weight of the model: 94.5 kg

Hope stands on an attached base plate which is included in the above dimensions.

The dimensions of the storage box which Hope will be transported in are:

- Height: 188cm
- Width: 95cm
- Depth: 79cm

- This model was designed for public contact.
- The model is made for indoor use only
- The model must be installed on a firm, level and stable surface.

The UK Parliament will be responsible for the costs for transportation of Hope.
